Coursera is a global online learning platform that works with universities and other organizations to offer online courses, certifications, and degrees in a variety of subjects. Course lengths range from a few hours to weeks and months.

Much of the learning you'll encounter on Coursera takes place asynchronously, meaning you can access course content and materials at your own pace. That way, you can build your learning into your schedule and around your other responsibilities.

We strongly recommend that students make the most of this valuable resource by taking as many courses as possible to help you to develop your skills, strategies, and confidence and to professionalize.
