

Honours Specialization in Rehabilitation Sciences

In order to progress into the Hon Spec in Rehabilitation Sciences after first year, students must achieve the following:

- Minimum grade of 60% in each of Health Sciences 1001A/B, 1002A/B and 1111A/B
- Minimum grade of 60% in Biology 1001A and 1002B (or Biology 1201A and 1202B)
- Minimum cumulative average of 65%

Enrolment is limited. Meeting the minimum requirement does not guarantee admission.

Note – make sure you have a minimum of 5.0 1000 level courses, maximum 7.0 allowed. Students must have a minimum of 13.0 senior credits to graduate.			
HS 1110A/B or HS 1111A/B is required if you were admitted to Health Sciences in 2020 or after. If admitted in 2019 or before you are not required to complete HS 1110A/B. Instead you would have a .5 1000 level elective in the box for a total of 5.0 1000 level courses.
