	Exposure to chemical- absorption, inhalation, ingestion, asphyxiation, irritation, breathing or vision difficulty	Please refer to the Chemical Mixing Job Analysis and use PPE appropriate for the certain application method. ES-65H SDS does not require mask when applied with cloth or a spray bottle but 3-ply medical style masks must be used when using sanitizer (E-sprayer) . The specific location of the task may also impact the PPE required. Eg. working in a space where occupants are isolating or sanitizing space where known positive cases have occupied the space.
